SUMMARY

Senior frontend engineer with 10+ years across consumer SaaS and agency work. Currently at Intuit Mailchimp, where I've shipped architecture for the marketing site's global navigation, driven Core Web Vitals improvements across high-traffic pages, and brought AI tooling into the team's daily engineering workflow. Strong at shipping durable, well-tested work and helping the engineers around me do the same.

- Senior engineer on Mailchimp's marketing site (mailchimp.com). Tech lead on the marketing-site engineering team, owning frontend and server-side work across pricing, the integrations search and content experience, and site performance. Promoted from Software Engineer III to Senior in August 2023.
- Drove AI tooling adoption across the marketing-site engineering team by building reusable Cursor rule files and leveraging Model Context Protocol (MCP) integrations that taught AI tools the team's codebase conventions and accelerated everyday engineering work.
- Architected the full rebuild of Mailchimp's global site navigation — authored the tech spec and designed every layer, from CMS content model through server-side rendering to client-side interaction with accessibility built in. Coordinated engineers, QA, and content operations to ship the localized rebuild on a tight timeline; drove an 18% sustained lift in click engagement on the new nav post-launch, and it remains the production navigation today.
- Led a site performance initiative on mailchimp.com — improved Core Web Vitals on high-traffic, high-conversion pages (including a 40% INP reduction on the pricing page and a 30% payload cut). The work tied performance to SEO ranking signals and to discoverability by AI-driven search; partnered with design and product to make site performance a cross-functional concern.
- Owned the integrations search and content experience on Mailchimp's marketing site and in-app. Diagnosed why each new integration launch required engineering, wrote a remediation plan, and shipped the infrastructure that let the content operations team manage launches and content updates without engineering involvement.
- Mentored engineers across teams through pairing, code review, and tech-spec coaching, and guided four into their first project-lead roles.
